## **GOLDEN TRIANGLE (Delhi / Agra / Jaipur / Delhi)**

PPT-01: DELHI - AGRA - JAIPUR - DELHI (3 Nights / 4 Days)



### **DAY 01: DELHI**

The Tour starts with Delhi Sightseeing.

Today enjoy a city tour of Delhi. Visit **Raj Ghat**, drive past **Jama Masjid** and the **Red Fort**. In the afternoon visit **Qutab Minar**, **Humayun Tomb**, and **India Gate**. During your tour, drive past the **President's House**, **Parliament House** and the **Government Secretariat Buildings**.

Day ends with a comfortable overnight stay at the hotel.



### **DAY 02: DELHI – AGRA (204 Kms / 5 Hrs drive)**

Early morning drive to Agra takes you to the historical and romantic city of Agra.

Enroute visit **Sikandara** - the mausoleum of Emperor Akbar.

Thereafter proceed to visit **Taj Mahal** built by Mughal Emperor Shahjahan in 1630 for his beloved Queen Mumtaz. Continue the tour visiting the **Agra Fort** containing the Royal residential palaces, the Halls of Public and Private Audience and beautiful gardens.

Overnight stay at the hotel.

*(Please note that Taj Mahal is Closed on Fridays)*



### DAY 03: AGRA – JAIPUR (232 Kms / 5 Hrs drive)

After breakfast, the morning will be at your Leisure. Later, Check-out of the hotel & proceed to the Pink City of Jaipur. Enroute visit **Fatehpur Sikri** - once the capital of Mughal Emperor Akbar. On arrival at Jaipur, check-in to your hotel. Afternoon, visit the **City Palace** and the **apartment housing museums** with an array of textiles, costumes, arms, weapons and paintings, **Hawamahal** and finally visit **Jantar-Mantar**, the observatory built by Maharaja Jai Singh-II.



Overnight stay at the hotel.

### DAY 04: JAIPUR – DELHI (250 Kms / 5 Hrs drive)

After Breakfast, this morning, you will proceed on a visit to **Amber**, the ancient capital of the Kachhawaha Rajputs. Pay directly for your Elephant ride or for the Jeep ride up to the fort. Later in afternoon transferred to the Delhi / Jaipur airport or railway station for your onward journey.

## **BEST OF KERALA (Cochin / Munnar / Kumarakom)**

### **PPT-02: COCHIN - MUNNAR - KUMARAKOM (4 Nights / 5 Days)**



#### **DAY 01: ARRIVE COCHIN**

Meeting and assistance upon arrival in Cochin airport and transfer to the hotel for check-in at the hotel.

Cochin is also known as '**Queen of the Arabian Sea**' due to its natural harbor, being one of the finest. Cochin is a city made of islands connected to Ernakulam on the mainland by bridges and ferries. The interesting city of Cochin perfectly reflect the eclecticism of Kerala. This quaint town has seen historic visits from sea faring traders in the past from Portugal, China etc bringing to it different cultures that make up its fabric. On arrival at Hotel, relax and freshen up. Later enjoy half day sightseeing tour visiting to Jewish Synagogue, St Francis Church, Chinese Fishing Net, Dutch Palace, Indo-Portuguese Museum.



Later return back on time for a cozy overnight stay at the hotel.

#### **DAY 02: COCHIN - MUNNAR (130 Kms / 4 Hrs)**

Breakfast at the hotel. Later drive to Munnar covering a distance of 130 kms / 4 hrs enroute visit Cheeyappara Waterfalls. On the way to Munnar you can see tea gardens spread like a green carpet over hundreds of kilometers, lush green hills, a place so difficult to describe, very low population too far from pollution, most of the area covered by Tata tea.

On arrival check-in at the hotel.

Overnight stay at the hotel.





### **DAY 03 : MUNNAR - KUMARAKOM (195 Kms / 6 Hrs)**

Morning sightseeing in Munnar which includes Raja Malai, a top peak of Munnar where you may see Neel Thar (mountain goats), Tea Museum, Mattupetty Dam, Eco-Point etc. Later drive to Kumarakom (195 Kms / 6 Hrs). On Arrival Check-in at the hotel.

Overnight stay at the hotel.



### **DAY 04: IN KUMARAKOM**

The lush green vegetation and the climate attract a number of tourists to this place.

Visit the Kumarakom Bird Sanctuary and later check in at the Houseboat. In Evening go for Sunset boat cruise.

Overnight stay at the hotel.



### **DAY 05: KUMARAKOM – COCHIN**

In the morning leisure at houseboat enjoying the beauty of backwater by just relaxing and enjoying the fresh air near Vembanad Lake.

Later Drive to cochin airport for onward journey.



## **HERITAGE RAJASTHAN (Rajasthan Tour)**

**PPT-03: JAIPUR - BIKANER - JAISALMER - JODHPUR - UDAIPUR (8 Nights / 9 Days)**



### **DAY 01: ARRIVE JAIPUR**

On arrival check-in to the the hotel.

Late Afternoon optional visit to Chokhi Dhani an ethnic village resort to view folk dances, puppet show, camel ride etc. and enjoy Rajasthani Dinner (OWN COST).

Overnight stay at the Hotel in Jaipur.



### **DAY 02: JAIPUR**

After breakfast excursion to Amber Fort, the Old capital of Jaipur Rulers.

Ride on the back of an elephant from the foots of the hill up to the gates of the fortress.

Afternoon sightseeing tour of Jaipur including Maharaja's museum and Jai Singh's Astronomical Observatory and Hawa Mahal.

Overnight stay at the hotel in Jaipur.



### **DAY 03: JAIPUR – BIKANER**

In the morning drive to Bikaner, this is true desert county and situated directly on the ancient caravan route which linked west / central Asia and North India.

On arrival transfer to the hotel. Evening visit the market.

Overnight stay at the Hotel in Bikaner.



#### DAY 04: BIKANER – JAISALMER

Morning drive to Jaisalmer. Arrive Jaisalmer and check-in at hotel.

Afternoon free time for leisure.

Overnight stay at the Hotel in Jaisalmer.

#### DAY 05: JAISALMER

In the morning your city sightseeing will include a tour of the Jaisalmer Fort where everything, including outer walls, temples and houses, are made of soft yellow Jurassic sandstone. Visit some of the countless havelis spread across Jaisalmer, which are reputed as the city's real showpieces. In the evening you will visit the Sam Sand Dunes of the Thar Desert a great place to see patterns carved out by winds on the sand. Experience an unforgettable camel ride through the dunes at sunset.



Overnight stay at the Hotel in Jaisalmer.

#### DAY 06: JAISALMER – JODHPUR

Today you will drive to a historic city of Jodhpur. Check-in at your hotel on arrival.

Evening visit imposing Mehrangarh Fort.

Overnight stay at the Hotel in Jodhpur.



#### DAY 07: JODHPUR – UDAIPUR

After enjoying breakfast, drive to Udaipur.

On arrival in Udaipur, check-in to the hotel.

Overnight at the hotel in Udaipur.

#### DAY 08: UDAIPUR

After a scrumptious breakfast, visit the exotic palaces and pleasure gardens. Move onto the Saheliyon Ki Badi - the Garden of the Maids of Honour, specially made for the Royal Ladies of Mewar.

Enjoy the rest of the afternoon at leisure or enjoy a boat ride on the picturesque Lake Pichola cruising past the spectacular City Palace, Jag Mandir Island and the famous Jag Niwas Island.



#### DAY 09: UDAIPUR

After breakfast today, transfer to the Udaipur airport to board a flight for onward journey.



## **SOUTH INDIA TEMPLE TOUR**

**PPT-04: CHENNAI - TIRUPATI - PUDUCHERRY - THANJAVUR - MAHABALIPURAM - CHENNAI (5 Nights / 6 Days)**



### **DAY 1: ARRIVE CHENNAI**

Welcome to Chennai, India's fourth largest city. Chennai, formerly known as Madras or Madarasapatinam, is the capital city of the Indian state of Tamil Nadu, located on the Coromandel Coast of the Bay of Bengal. On arrival at Chennai airport or railway station, begin your tour of 'Southern Odyssey'. You will be met and transferred to your hotel. In the afternoon, proceed for city tour of Chennai visiting Fort St. George, San Thome Church, the Kapileshwar Temple in Mylapore and finally Marina Beach, the second longest beach in the world.



Overnight stay at the Hotel.

### **DAY 2: CHENNAI - TIRUPATI (150 Kms / 4 Hrs drive)**

In morning, drive to Tirupati. Tirumala's Balaji shrine is among the more famous temples of India. It has a reputation of being one of the richest shrines in the world.

On arrival, check-in at your hotel. In the afternoon, visit the Balaji Temple for darshan of Lord Venkateshwara.

Overnight stay at the Hotel.



### **DAY 3: TIRUPATI - PUDUCHERRY (275 Kms / 7 Hrs drive)**

Today, you will drive to the city of Puducherry. A trip to Puducherry is like a journey in time with a vibrant present celebrating its interesting past. On arrival, check in at the hotel. In the afternoon, visit the township of Auroville and the Church of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Overnight stay at the Hotel.



#### **DAY 4: PUDUCHERRY - THANJAVUR (177 Kms / 4 Hrs drive)**

Today, proceed to Thanjavur. Thanjavur derives its name from Tanjanan asura (giant), who according to local legend devastated the neighbourhood and was killed by Sri Anandavalli Amman and Vishnu. Sri Neelamegapperumal Tanjan's last request that the city might be named after him was granted. Chola, Chera and Pandya kings were ruling Tamizhagam even before Mahabharat period. In the afternoon, visit the famous Brihadeeshwara Temple built in the 10th century, the Palace, housing the Tamil University Museum, the Art Gallery and the Saraswati Mahal Library which houses palm leaf and paper manuscripts. The evening is at leisure.



Overnight stay at the Hotel.

#### **DAY 5: THANJAVUR - MAHABALIPURAM**

The most famous monument here is the Shore Temple, which looks absolutely mesmerizing when lit by moonlight. Mahabalipuram beach is famous for its marvelous monuments that include panels, sculptural, Monolithic Rathas (chariots), caves, and temples. The Pallavas art at this place emphasizes robust earthly beauty, imbued with life. These monumental splendors and the sunny beach resorts attract tourists from all over the world.



Overnight stay at the Hotel.

#### **Day 6: MAHABALIPURAM - CHENNAI**

Day at leisure. Later transfer to Chennai airport / railway station for your onward journey.

## A TASTE OF THE HILLS (Darjeeling & Gangtok)

### PPT-05: DARJEELING – GANGTOK (4 Nights / 5 Days)



#### DAY 01: BAGDOGRA/NJP – DARJEELING (93 Kms / 3 Hrs drive)

Assistance at the airport / station on arrival and drive to Darjeeling.

##### **DARJEELING:**

Standing high in the Himalayas at an altitude of 2134m, ‘Dorje Ling’, or place of the Thunderbolt, offers breathtaking views of snow-capped mountain peaks, with the Kanchendzonga rising higher than all the others. Often referred to as the “Queen of the Hills”, it remains just as alluring with its tiny waterfalls, little villages and a narrow gauge railway track. Surrounded by World Famous Tea Gardens and snow capped mountains, Darjeeling remains one of the most exotic destinations. Graeme Westlake in his book ‘An introduction to hill stations on India’ refers to Darjeeling as having “A view Scarcely Unrivalled on Earth”.



Overnight at the hotel.

#### DAY 02: DARJEELING

Early morning visit Tiger Hill to see a beautiful sunrise and Himalayan Range like Kanchandzonga, Mount Everest etc. One can see the horizon changing colors just before sunrise and then the entire Himalayan range turn golden. It is truly a majestic sight and Ghoom Monastery which is oldest Monastery in the area which was built in 1875 and one can see the image of Mythey Buddha 15ft. height on the way back from Tiger Hill.



Breakfast at the hotel and proceed for city tour visiting Himalayan Mountaineering Institute (closed on Thursday) which was started by Tenzing Norgay after he climbed Mt. Everest, Zoological Park (closed on Thursday), Tibetan Refugee Centre (closed on Sunday), Tenzing Rock, Gombu Rock and Tea Estate (from outside).

Overnight at the hotel.

### DAY 03: DARJEELING - GANGTOK (98 Kms / 4 Hrs drive)

Breakfast at the hotel and drive to Gangtok.

#### **GANGTOK:**

At an altitude of 1750m, Gangtok became the state capital in the mid 19th century and has undergone rapid development since then. The downtown area is dominated by huge government buildings decorated with traditional Buddhist symbols. Gangtok is also a resting ground for people traveling to North Sikkim. Surrounded by Monasteries and Orchids, Gangtok is truly a travellers delight.



Afternoon sightseeing in Gangtok visiting Do Drul Chorten, Namgyal Institute of Tibetology (closed on Sundays), Cottage Industry (closed on Sundays), Flower Show Complex and Rumtek Monastery.

**Overnight at the hotel.**

### DAY 04: GANGTOK

Breakfast at the hotel and full day excursion to Changu Lake which is 35 Kms from Gangtok at an altitude of 12,400 feet. The lake derives its waters from melting snows off the surrounding mountains. Legends say that lamas could forecast the future by studying the color of the lake's waters.



Overnight at the hotel.

### DAY 05: GANGTOK - BAGDOGRA/NJP (125 Kms / 4 Hrs drive)

Breakfast at the hotel and drive to Bagdogra/NJP in time for flight / train to onward destination.



## **TASTE OF EASTERN INDIA (Kolkata & Bhubaneswar)**

### **PPT-06: KOLKATA – BHUBANESWAR - PURI (4 Nights / 5 Days)**



#### **DAY 01: ARRIVAL - KOLKATA**

Arrive at Kolkata airport and assisted transfer to hotel.

Afternoon proceed for a half day city tour visiting Victoria Memorial (closed on Monday), St. Paul's Cathedral, Mother House (closed on Thursday) and river side.

Overnight stay at the hotel in Kolkata.



#### **DAY 02: KOLKATA - BHUBANESWAR**

Morning half day excursion to Dakshineswar Kali Temple & Belur math. Afternoon transfer to Kolkata airport to board on flight to Bhubaneswar.

Arrive Bhubaneswar and Check-in at the hotel.



#### **DAY 03: BHUBANESWAR - KONARK - PURI**

Morning after breakfast drive to Puri enroute visit Dhauli (Budhist stupa / peace pagoda), Pipli (the applique work village) and Konark Sun Temple. Then proceed to Puri and check-in at the hotel.

Evening visit of Lord Jagannath Temple (Non Hindus are not allowed) / Relax on the golden beach of Puri.

Overnight stay at the hotel in Puri.





#### **DAY 04 : PURI – CHILKA - PURI**

Morning drive to Chilika lake at Satpada (the largest Ramsar site of Asia and famous for its migratory birds coming from distance places). Take the boat cruise to visit the Irrawaddy Dolphins & Rajhans Island. Return back to Puri. Evening visit to beach market.

Overnight stay at the hotel in Puri.



#### **DAY 05: PURI - BHUBANESWAR & DEPARTURE**

Drive back to Bhubaneswar enroute visit Raghurajpur (Artisan village) and Khandagiri & Udaigiri Jain caves (oldest rock cut caves, the caves are reminiscent of influence of Buddhism and Jainism in Odisha (Orissa).

Then proceeds to Bhubaneswar and transfer to airport to board the flight for onwards journey.
